Email	<p>Heading/title: Psoriatic Arthritis Priority Setting Partnership – Top Ten Psoriatic Arthritis Research Priorities Announced by BritPACT</p> <p>Main text: Dear All,</p> <p>The British Psoriatic Arthritis Consortium worked with the James Lind Alliance to run a priority setting partnership (PSP).</p> <p>We have created a national top 10 list of research priorities for psoriatic arthritis, agreed upon by patients, carers and clinicians. This marks the culmination of the psoriasis arthritis PSP.</p> <p>We are delighted to reveal the Top Ten Psoriatic Arthritis Research Priorities, agreed upon by people who are living with psoriatic arthritis, carers and healthcare professionals. This 'Top Ten' list – the culmination of the psoriatic arthritis Priority Setting Partnership (PSP) - will be considered by research funders to ensure future psoriatic arthritis research focuses on the areas that matter most to the people in the UK who live with the condition, and those involved in its care and treatment. The final Top Ten has been added to this email as an attachment.</p> <p>The project followed the James Lind Alliance's Priority Setting Partnership method, and began with an open call for psoriatic arthritis stakeholders to submit the questions that they wanted answering about the condition and its treatments. Nearly one thousand questions were received from people living with the condition, their families, GPs, Rheumatologists, Allied Health Professionals, Nurses and others.
