The James Lind Alliance ([www.lindalliance.org](http://www.lindalliance.org)) Schizophrenia Priority Setting Partnership has produced a 'long list' of 237 unanswered research questions (or 'uncertainties') about the treatment of schizophrenia (see form B).

These are from the UK Database of Uncertainties about the Effects of Treatments (UK DUETs: [www.library.nhs.uk/duets](http://www.library.nhs.uk/duets)) and originated from consultation with patients, carers and clinicians. We now need to create a shortlist of these unanswered research questions for consideration at a priority setting workshop (Monday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2011). The overall aim of the workshop will be to rank 10 shortlisted research questions in order of importance.

We are asking all our partners to complete this exercise. Those participating as individuals have one 'vote' each. If you are representing an organisation, your organisation gets one vote. If, as an organisation, you are consulting members, it is up to you how you do it - there is space at the end of this form to describe what you did.
